



Entries open for 14th Yarmouth Art Festival

Entries are now open for the 2022 Yarmouth Art Festival, a premier juried showcase for Maine artists since 2009. Deadline is 6pm Sept. 16.

This year's 14th annual show will be a hybrid of in-person and fully virtual: in-person Oct. 19-22, and online Oct. 19-Nov. 5. The show will be held at St. Bartholomew's Episcopal Church, 396 Gilman Road in Yarmouth.

Artists enter their artwork via an online submission process at www.yarmouthartfestival.com. Instructions and rules are on the website. Please read the Rules and FAQs carefully before entering. Entry fees and sales commissions support local community nonprofits, which will be named in September.

The in-person event will observe all Covid precautions in effect at the time of the show in October.

- **Bob Keyes**, editorial director at Colby College in Waterville, and formerly arts reporter for the Maine Sunday Telegram.
