

## ST. BART'S PRAYER LISTS

The Pastoral Care Committee believes in the power of prayer and is grateful to have the St. Bart's congregation pray for those in need. At any time, a church member may request that their name, a family member, or a friend's name be added to either the General Prayer List or the Prayer List for Those Who have Died.

### How to request a name to be added to the General Prayer List

- Requests may be submitted to the Pastoral Care e-mail ([pastoralcare@stbartsyarmouth.org](mailto:pastoralcare@stbartsyarmouth.org)), a Pastoral Care member, the Parish Administrator -846-9244, or Amanda, our priest.
- Please know that the Pastoral Care Committee members maintain confidentiality unless they are otherwise advised to share health or personal information with our minister and/or the Pastoral Care Committee.
- We ask that all requests be followed with periodic updates, so the General Prayer List remains current.
- If the Committee has not received any updated information within approximately three months, then a member will seek an update.
- Names will be removed from the prayer list with the permission of the person who added the name.

### How to request a name be added to the Prayer List for Those Who have Died

- When the Priest, Parish Administrator, or a member of the Pastoral Care Committee is notified that a current or former Church member has died, the name of the deceased person will be added to the Prayer List for Those Who have Died.
- St. Bart's members may request to have the name of a loved one, a family member or friend, included on this list.
- Requests may be submitted to the Pastoral Care e-mail ([pastoralcare@stbartsyarmouth.org](mailto:pastoralcare@stbartsyarmouth.org)), a Pastoral Care member, the Parish Administrator in the church office at 846-9244, or Amanda, our Priest.
- Directly after learning of the passing of a parishioner, family member or friend, that person's name will appear in the Church bulletin and the St. Bart's e-bulletin for two (2) consecutive weeks.
- The grieving family or individuals are listed in the General Prayers for the same two weeks.
